<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Children express themselves effectively, showing awareness of the listeners needs They use past, present and future forms accurately when talking about events that have happened or are to happen in the future They develop their own narratives and explanations by connecting ideas or events 		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Listen attentively in a range of situations Listen to stories accurately anticipating key events and respond to what they hear with relevant comments, questions and actions Give their attention to what others say and respond appropriately, while engaged in another activity Children follow instructions involving several ideas or actions They answer 'how' or 'why' questions about their experiences and in response to stories or events

<p><u>Comprehension</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Demonstrate understanding when talking with others about what they have read Read and understand simple sentences <p><u>Word reading</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Read some common irregular words Use phonic knowledge to decode regular words and read them aloud accurately 	<p><u>Writing composition</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Write simple sentences which can be read by themselves and others <p><u>Spelling</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Use phonic knowledge to write words in ways which match spoken sounds Write common irregular words <p>Some words are spelt correctly and others are phonetically plausible</p> <p><u>Handwriting</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Handle equipment and tools effectively, including pencils for writing 	<p><u>Number System and Place Value</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Count reliably with numbers 1-20 Place numbers in order Say which is 1 more and 1 less than a given number <p><u>Calculation</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Use quantities and objects to add and subtract 2 single digit numbers Count on and back to find an answer <p><u>Shape, Space and Measure</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Use everyday language to talk about, compare quantities and object and to solve problems: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <i>Size</i> <i>Weight</i> <i>Capacity</i> <i>Position</i> <i>Distance</i> <i>Time</i> Recognise, create and describe patterns Explore characteristics of everyday objects and shapes and use mathematical language to describe them <p><u>Problem Solving and Application</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Solve problems, including doubling, halving and sharing 	<p><u>Understanding the World – Technology</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Recognise that a range of technology is used in places such as homes and schools Select and use technology for particular purposes: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <i>Access word banks</i> <i>Draw pictures</i> <i>Word processing</i> <i>Create a simple pictogram</i> <i>Recording sounds</i> <i>Simple instructions (left / right)</i> <i>Navigate a website (forward / backward)</i> <p><u>E Safety</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Follow safety rules on web Keep private information safe Identify where to go for help and support when they have concerns about their E Safety
