

Wales Primary School Basic Skills: Year 1

Talking to others

- Able to express feelings and ideas when speaking about matters of immediate interest.
- Can talk in ways that are audible and intelligible to peers.
- Show some awareness of the listener by adjusting spoken language and using body language
- Read out own writing clearly to an audience

Talking with others

- Listen attentively and engage with the speaker.
- Take turns in small group situations or with talking partner.
- Can listen to what others in group suggest and then say what they agree with.

Reading and Phonics

Comprehension

- Able to predict what happens next in key stories
- Know difference between fiction and non-fiction books
- Know to stop at a full stop
- Become familiar with key stories
- Checking for sense and correcting miscues
- Reread own writing to check for sense

Word reading

- Read up to 100 familiar words.
- Blend and segment all 40+ phonemes including alternative sounds for graphemes
- Read aloud with accuracy

Writing, SPaG and Handwriting

Writing composition

- Sequence sentences to form short narratives
 - Leave spaces between words
 - Discuss what they have written
- ### Spelling (*appendix 1*)
- Key words containing each of 40+ phonemes taught
 - Days of the week and numbers
 - Recognise and name all the letters of the alphabet
 - Make words plural (*s, es*)
 - Change root words (*er, est, ing, ed*)

Punctuation

- Write simple sentences.
- Use capital letters to start sentences and full stops to end them
- Use Question marks and Exclamation marks at the end of sentences

Grammar (*terminology in appendix 2*)

- Personal pronoun I used in sentences
- Capital letters for proper nouns
- Conjunction sentences (*and, because*)

Handwriting

- Correct pencil grip and posture
- Correct letter formation using appropriate flicks
- Use the four basic joins
- Accurate use of capital letters

Numeracy and Mathematics

Number System and Place Value

- Form digits 0 to 9 accurately
- Count to and across 100 going forwards and backwards from a given number.
- Count, read and write numbers to 100
- Count in 2s, 5s and 10s
- Know more and less than a number

Calculation

- Addition and subtraction facts to 20
- Add and subtract 1 digit and 2 digit numbers to 20 using a numberline
- Use objects to double and halve numbers by grouping and sharing

Fractions

- Recognise, find and name halves and quarters of objects, shapes and quantities

Shape, Space and Measure

- Compare, measure and describe:
Length and height
Mass and weight
Capacity and volume
Time (hour and half past)
- Know the values of coins and notes
- Chronological sequencing using language (*days of week, months*)
- Recognise and name common 2D and 3D shapes
- Describe position and movement ($\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$ turns)

Problem Solving and Application

- Solve one step problems using addition, subtraction, multiplication and division including missing numbers
- Solve practical problems for length / height, mass / weight, capacity / volume and time

Computing, ICT and E Safety

Computing

- Create and debug simple programmes (*eg Daisy the Dinosaur*)
- Predict what will happen in simple programmes

ICT

- Access and use a word or picture bank
- Word process simple text
- Collect basic data in a chart
- Create a pictogram and answer simple questions
- Record sounds and play back
- Create simple series of instructions: understand 'left' and 'right'
- Use forward and backwards when navigating a website

E Safety

- Follow safety rules on web
- Recognise common uses of IT beyond school
- Use technology safely and respectfully
- Know where to go for help and support regarding E Safety concerns
